# INTRODUCTION

- Year 2000 is a designated DAISRC Program
- Individual Year 2000 projects:
  - ◆ May or may not fall under full DAISRC oversight
  - ◆ However, some information must be reported to the Y2K Program Office
- Y2K Certification Checklist information is reportable

# PROCESS OVERVIEW

## Continued

- Y2K Individual Project Completes Certification Checklist based on Unit Integration(System) Test
- Y2K Program Office Follow Up on Completed Checklist:
  - ◆ Answers Understandable
  - ◆ Answers Do Not Conflict
  - ◆ Obtain Any Additional Information Needed



# PROCESS OVERVIEW

## Continued

- Y2K Program Office Adds Data from Certification Checklist to Y2K Database
- Y2K Program Office Makes Certification Recommendation
- Product Line Manager will conduct CSCI Qualification(Functional) Test
- Product Line Manager will coordinate with Customer/Business Area to obtain certification



# PROCESS OVERVIEW

## Continued

- Inform EDs/CCB of Certification status
- Forward Information to HQ DLA if appropriate
- EDs/CCB/HQ DLA Agree/Disagree with Y2K Certification Action
- If Not Y2K Certified - Take Required Action
